

<b>FACTS</b>	<b>WHAT DOES PC DEBIT CARD DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?</b>
<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Application Information:</b> This is the information you provide us on applications and through other means as part of an application process</li> <li>• <b>Transaction and Experience Information:</b> This includes information about your transactions and account experience, as well as information about our communications with you.</li> <li>• <b>Consumer Reporting Information:</b> This includes the information and consumer report we may obtain from a consumer reporting agency</li> <li>• <b>Social Security Numbers and Employment Information</b></li> <li>• <b>Information from Outside Sources:</b> This could include information we receive regarding your employment, credit, or other relationships</li> <li>• <b>Survey and Research Information:</b> This includes information you provide to us through a survey or research questions we may ask you</li> <li>• <b>Other General Information:</b> This includes information from outside sources such as public records.</li> </ul> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share customer’s personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer’s personal information; the reason The PC Debit Card chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<p>Who is providing this notice?</p>	<p>The PC Debit Card LLC., and its subsidiaries and affiliates, is providing this privacy notice and it applies to products and services provided by the company. This privacy notice also applies to our associated agents and servicers that may provide services on our behalf.</p>
<p><b>What we do</b></p>	<p></p>
<p>How does The PC Debit Card protect your personal information?</p>	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with industry standards. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>We restrict access to your information to those employees who need to know it to provide products and services to you.</p>
<p>How does The PC Debit Card collect my personal information?</p>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Submit any application</li> <li>• Open an account or deposit money</li> <li>• Pay any bills</li> <li>• Apply for or make payments on a loan</li> <li>• Use your debit card</li> <li>• Give us your income information</li> <li>• Give us your contact information</li> <li>• Tell us where to send your money</li> <li>• Provide account information</li> <li>• Show us your government-based identification</li> <li>• Respond to a survey or research questions</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
<p>Why can't I limit all sharing</p>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit some but not all sharing related to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Affiliate's everyday business purposes- information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• Nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to all users of the account.

Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies.</p> <p>Our affiliates include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The PC Debit Card LLC, Bank of America</li> </ul>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p>Nonaffiliates we share with include collection agencies, servicers, consumer reporting agencies, contract buyers, investors, database providers, and others.</p>
Joint Marketing	<p>Formal agreements between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p>Our joint marketers may include financial services companies.</p>
