

Dear veteran service officer or counselor,

The veteran organizations of South Carolina are in the process of establishing the New Veteran's One-stop Resource and Referral Network (VRRN).

The VRRN provides easy access to all veteran resources in one location, with one call or one click, updated daily by our student technology and production teams from area colleges and high schools.

One of our first programs is the "Veteran Service-Day" established to help veterans who are in-need-of help with their benefits, claims, applications or basic living needs.

We are currently scheduling Veteran Service Officers, Counselors and Resource Information Volunteers to serve during the Tuesday Veteran-Service Day from 12pm to 6pm.

The network is also in the planning stages of establishing the Myrtle Beach Veteran Service Officer Training Academy and the Annual VEAC to be held at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center. We are seeking your input, expertise and participation.

The Service Day will be followed by a fellowship and networking session at 6pm to further collect, manage and introduce all local veteran services and information.

THE VETERAN'S SERVICE-DAY & FELLOWSHIP WILL CONSIST OF:

- 1. Veteran Service Officers and Resource Reps to serve veterans (one on one and/or group sessions).
- 2. Veteran Organizations presenting and sharing their information.
- 3. Students from local colleges gathering and archiving information and conducting photo and video shoots.
- 4. Veteran presenters, vendors and display tables for funders and veteran organizations.
- 5. Filming of the Brave Heart's Podcast and interviews for the Brave Heart's Magazine.
- 6. Fellowship and Networking Night with fun-activities, light food, refreshments and beverages.
